Worthing is a town in the south of England	
Worthing is near to the South Downs	
Worthing is on the coast	
The sea is called the English Channel	
Heene is a part of Worthing	
Heene is an area of the town where people live	
There are shops, businesses and schools in Heene	
There are two train stations nearby:	
Worthing Station and West Worthing	
Victoria Park is green space in Heene
