Reading:

Year 5 and 6 will be starting a new scheme called AR (Accelerated Reading). More detailed information will follow in the next couple of weeks. It is expected that children are **completing at least 4 (20 minute) sessions of reading a week**. We will be sharing the format of recording these reads over the next week. We would like children to experience reading a range of different types of text this year, varying their choice of author.

Homework:

Maths will be sent out on a **Monday** and is due back in on the **Friday** of the same week.

English/Topic will be sent out on a <u>Tuesday</u> and needs to be back in school, no later than the following <u>Monday</u>.

Spelling: Spelling tests will normally be held on a <u>Friday</u>. New spellings for the week will be given out on the same day.

Your child will also have a copy of the '100 curriculum' spelling words for Years 5 and 6.

These are the words that the children need to be able to spell by the end of Year 6. In addition we have sent out the Year 3 and 4 list for consolidation
