YEAR 2 VISIT TO AMBERLEY – Wednesday 6th March 2019

As part of our Transport topic we are pleased to inform you that we have arranged a visit to Amberley Museum. The children will be looking at how transport has changed over time.

We will be travelling by coach and leaving school at 9.15am precisely so please ensure that your child is on time as usual for prompt registration at 8.50am. We will be back at school between 3.15pm – 3.30pm. We need a few adult volunteers. If you can help please can you let the teacher know and we will contact you.

Medicines Note: If your child needs travel sickness medication during the trip please ask the office for a consent form. We cannot give your child the medicine if you do not complete this form.

Your child needs to wear school jumper, trousers (jeans, joggers or leggings) a suitable coat and footwear; bring a bottle of water (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks), a snack and a packed lunch. If you normally pay Chartwells for a school meal please ensure you do not order for **Wednesday 6th March 2019**, and provide your child with a packed lunch instead. Please pack these in a named 'back pack' style bag as the children need their hands free. If your child currently has free school meals Chartwells can provide a pack lunch please complete the appropriate section on ParentPay.

We would ask you to make a voluntary contribution of £15.20 to cover the cost of this visit. All payments need to be paid via ParentPay. Please make your payment no later than **Thursday 14th February 2019**. Although we are able to subsidise trips to some degree, unless those parents who are able to make a contribution do so, it is probable that these visits could not take place. We appreciate that some families might find it difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum and, if you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to speak to one of us or the Head Teacher in confidence. All children will be included in the visit.
