<u>Aims</u>

- To aid each child's progress towards achieving his or her full potential with the assistance, support and co-operation of parents/carers.
- Home learning will be set on a regular basis and is designed to consolidate children's key maths and English skills to support their learning in the classroom.

Objectives

- To provide an enjoyable, purposeful and positive supplement to class work.
- To provide opportunities for the child to gain independence and take responsibility for organising their own work.
- To provide opportunities for the child to practice what has been learnt in class.
- To provide an opportunity for parents to become involved in the academic development of their child.

What is Home Learning?

Home Learning is any task that a child is asked to complete at home. At Heene CE Primary School we recognise the developmental needs of the whole child. We appreciate the value of extracurricular activities (sports, music, dance, drama, etc.). However, Home Learning is an integral part of supporting each child's academic progress.

Following on from the parent and child consultation, our recent Ofsted Inspection (July 2018), our School Key Priorities and consultation with teaching staff (Autumn term 2018), we have agreed that:

- The Home Learning sent home by staff (Appendix 1) will be differentiated.
- Pupils will take responsibility for their home learning, complete it to the best of their ability and take
 pride in their presentation.
- Parents/carers will support their child's home learning, encourage them to persevere, ask questions and provide, where possible, a quiet undisturbed environment.
