What I should already know

- My parents are older than I am.

What I will know by the end of the unit (Historical skills and enquiry)

- I will be able to look at the visual timetable in the classroom and know that it shows the order in which things happen.
- I will know that some things we do happen before other things.
- I will be able to show (using words, pictures or a simple time line) some things which happened before I was born eg birth of older sibling.
- I will be able to place the births of my grandparents, parents and myself in order and put it on a timeline
- I will know that I can look at pictures and use them to decide which pictures, photos and illustrations show people or places in the past and which show them in the present day.
- I will be able to compare picture of me and my family now and in the past
- I will know that some things happened in the more recent past (eg birth of my parents) and some things happened in the distant past (eg birth of Jesus).

- I will learn how Mary and Joseph had to travel to Bethlehem on foot or by donkey because a long time ago they didn't have trains, planes or cars.
