PE Times:

Both Pandas and Panthers will have P.E. on Mondays (Spring and Summer) and Wednesdays. Please can you make sure that your child has the full P.E. kit in school including suitable footwear. In colder weather please send in tracksuit bottoms and a warm top. Hair must be tied up. Jewellery must be removed for P.E. lessons.

Reading:

Your child will be bringing home their Reading Journal. We are asking that children read regularly at home and record this in their journal. We would appreciate your support with encouraging your child to read at home. Getting together for just 10 minutes a day or several times a week has an incredibly positive impact on your child's confidence and achievement across the curriculum.

Reading, Spelling and Times Tables Homework:

Times Tables will be set on Times Tables Rockstars and it is expected that your child logs on and practises at least <u>5</u> times a week. Times Tables test will happen during Mental Maths on a Friday.

Reading Journals are expected in school each day and must be <u>handed in</u> to your class teacher on a **Tuesday.**

Spelling: Spelling tests will be held fortnightly on a <u>Tuesday</u>. New spellings for the week will be stuck in to your reading journal each week. With your help, we will be encouraging your child to use their spelling words within a written sentence to help them make the link between learning spellings and using them correctly in their writing.
