

PE Times:

Reading:

Your child will soon be bringing home Reading Journal. We are asking that children read at least 4 times a week at home and record this in their journal. We would appreciate your support with encouraging your child to read at home. Getting together for just 10 minutes a day or several times a week can have an incredibly positive impact on your child's confidence and achievement.



Homework:

Your child will have a piece of Maths and English/ Topic and Spelling homework each week.

Maths and English/Topic will be sent out on a Thursday and needs to be back in school, no later than the following Wednesday.

Spelling: Spelling tests will normally be held on a Monday and when this is not possible, the test will be done the next day. New spellings for the week will be given out on a Thursday with homework. Please encourage your child to use their spelling words within a written sentence to help them make the link between learning spellings and using them correctly in their writing.
