**Slides** – each slide in a presentation

**Presentation** – a person/people teaching or showing another person/group of people something

**Transition** – when the slides have different effects when you move from one to another.

**Hyperlinks**- Also known as a web link or link, a hyperlink is an icon, graphic or text that when clicked on links to another file/object/webpage.

**Audio** – sound

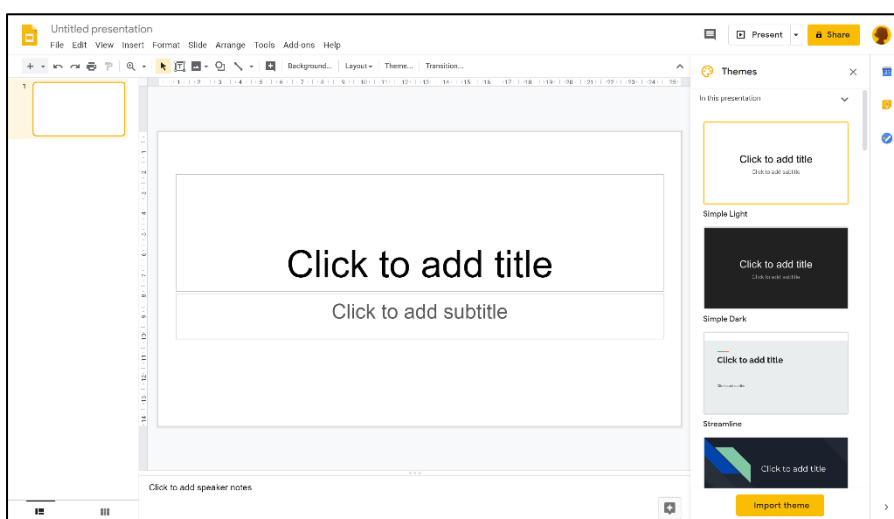
**Video** – recording and broad casting moving images.

- Use video or audio as part of their presentation.

### **Possible modification and challenge:**

**Modification** – Pictorial representations of different slides. Key words for their topic written down. A picture of a keyboard showing upper and lower case.

**Challenge** – to be an expert and help other children but not allowed to touch their computers. Include different fonts, images, videos to make it interesting for the listener. Able to present their slides with confidence and able to transition between slides.
