In addition to Mrs. Hill, we will also be saying farewell to Mr. Brown, who is re-locating with his family, Mrs. Clift, who is retiring as is Mrs. Toni. We wish all our colleagues, warmest thanks and every happiness and they move on from Heene.

We are looking to appoint a new SENCO to Heene and whilst we go through that important process we are very grateful to Mrs. Gemma Irvine (Headteacher at St Mary's) for supporting us in the interim situation, ensuring our SEN provision is a real strength at Heene.

















Covid-19 Update:

You will be aware that on Tuesday we again heard from our Prime Minister about the decision to delay the full reopening of restrictions until July 19th. This has clearly had an impact on some of the things we had planned for the children and we will aim to keep you fully informed of these as we journey the coming few weeks together. As a result of this new change we will unfortunately not be able to hold Summer Parent Consultations in school this term. These will be held instead through our Google Classroom / Google Meet provision. Your child's end of year report will come to you on Friday 2nd July with the Parent Consultations being held following this on Tuesday 6th July (3.30pm – 7pm) and Thursday 8th July (3.30pm – 5.30pm). You will be invited to book a 10 minute 'virtual' appointment with your child's class teacher to discuss the report and this can be done 'on e-schools' from Wednesday 23rd June. Full details of how to join the Google Meet will be sent to you in a separate communication to ensure you can all set up an appointment of these time.
